General Rules and Regulations

- ◆ All teams must have a provision for hand washing and vending teams must meet the Tri-County Health Department guidelines. Guidelines will be mailed in your confirmation packet and are available at <http://www.tchd.org/restaurants.html> Please select at the bottom of page Temporary Food Event pages 1-3 or contact Tri-County Health at (303) 663-7650.
- ◆ Up-to-date fire extinguishers are required. The recommended size is 2A:10B: C. It must have a current inspection tag.
- ◆ Receptacles for ashes will be available for dumping hot ashes throughout the contest.
- ◆ Please provide your own trash receptacles for your booth. Dumpsters will be conveniently located for trash dumping.
- ◆ Port let restrooms (no shower facilities) are located throughout the event.
- ◆ Water will be available in two locations, shown on the map.
- ◆ Grey water, grease and ash may only be disposed of at locations indicated on the map. Proper fees will be assessed for illegal dumping.
- ◆ Teams using electricity must provide their own extension cords. Extension cords must be a minimum of 12 gauge and be in good working order.

Electricity: One 110volt, 12 amp max. draw will be available. Please contact us if additional is required. **YOU WILL BE CHARGED BY OUR ELECTRICIAN FOR ANY ADDITIONAL POWER**

Information Regarding Food and Beverage Purchases

- ◆ Teams/Vendors may **NOT** sell soft drinks, bottled water or alcoholic beverages. All beverages will be sold at the Smokin' Brew BBQ beverage booths.
- ◆ Teams/vendors may NOT accept cash for the purchase of food and beverage products. In order to purchase food or beverages at the Smokin' Brew BBQ event, attendees must trade in their cash for Smokin' Tickets. Smokin' Tickets are sold via the Smokin' Tickets booth and Rovers throughout the venue. Smokin' Tickets are paid to food & beverage vendors for product, and then collected and counted by event staff. Smokin' Brew BBQ will deduct sales tax and 20% commission; pay the sales tax to the State of Colorado and the Town of Parker, and then pay the remaining balance to the vendor.
- ◆ If security or event staff reports that a vendor is selling product for cash, Smokin' Brew BBQ will collect an extra 15% commission on that vendor's sales (or withhold equivalent winnings if not a vending team), totaling a 35% commission on total vendor sales. After a second offense the vendor/ team will be asked to leave. This rule will be STRICTLY ENFORCED.
- ◆ Vending teams may not close down until 6pm on Sunday afternoon. Please plan to have enough food to stay open until the end of the event. If you do run out of food, the Smokin' Brew BBQ understands that can happen; however, for the safety of the public, you may not PULL OUT until 7pm. If a vendor tries to pull out before 7pm on Sunday afternoon, the Smokin' Brew BBQ will collect an additional 10% commission on that vendors sales.
- ◆ Please note that if you already have a license to vend at another CO event for this year, you will not have to pay for a Temp/Mobile license for Tri-County Health. **Do not forget to retain a copy of the previous license to send in.**
- ◆ If you are selling an item not on your menu, you will be asked to stop selling it. There will be **NO EXCLUSIVITY** for food sales

Meat Inspection

- ◆ All meats cooked at the Smokin' Brew BBQ must be USDA-approved meat or have been purchased from a USDA-inspected source. Cookers must be able to show proof of this.
- ◆ Meat Inspections will be conducted from 9am-4pm on Saturday; A contest representative will certify that the meat begins raw.
- ◆ All KCBS Rules apply to competition meats.

Anything Butt & Sauce

- ◆ Entry in contests does not require on site preparation. The item must be prepared by your team and not purchased.
- ◆ We will provide a container for turn in. However, if you wish, you can submit your entry in your own container. We will not be responsible for return of such containers.

Waiver of Liability: *Must be signed.* In consideration of the Cherry Creek Valley Rotary accepting this entry.
